RMHCC VOLUNTEER REINSTATEMENT - RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE CHARITIES OF THE CAROLINAS

WELCOME BACK!! Volunteers returning will be required to go through a COVID orientation as it pertains to the operations of our house as a RMHCC Volunteer. It will reflect a new way of navigating through the House with attention to four key components MASKING, SOCIAL DISTANCING, HANDWASHING and DISINFECTION OF ALL TOUCH POINT AREAS. Acknowledging and signing this document will assure an understanding of the return to volunteerism to the RMHCC for your safety and the safety of families, staff and visitors.

On Campus Safety and Health Protocols:

- Complete the COVID Volunteer Orientation.
- Follow all House directives to ensure your safety and the safety of others who stay at our House – these include complying with all social distancing requirements, wearing a face covering while on campus, following the informational posters displayed around the House.
- If you go on vacation out of the city please adhere to CDC requirement of a 10-14 day quarantine prior to returning.
- If you are exposed to someone who has tested positive please let us know for the safety of our families. We will require a negative COVID test prior to returning or what is deemed by current CDC guidelines and RMHC Global.
- As a volunteer within our program please mindful of health protocols to keep yourself safe. We encourage vaccinations for your safety and those around you. Keep the Volunteer Coordinator and the Director of Operations informed of areas of concern.
- Handwashing requires washing for 20 seconds or use of 60% alcohol hand sanitizer located throughout the House focus on before and after volunteer shifts, after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing; after using the restroom; before eating or preparing food; and after putting on, touching, or removing your cloth face coverings
- Please refer to the RMHCC cleaning-disinfection protocols that should be followed after any visitors enter and are screened. All individuals entering must wear face masks, go through wellness and temp check (not to exceed 99.5)
- Your signature acknowledges that you are willingly engaging in RMHCC volunteer opportunities, events and/or other fundraising activities and waive and forever discharge any and all liability. Claims and demands against RMHCC, their directors, officers, employees.

We are dedicated to ensuring a safe work/volunteer environment. You acknowledge at this date of signing, you are not aware of any symptoms, signs or otherwise have reason to believe you have COVID or have been exposed. Thank you for wanting make a difference, you are the reason we can still achieve our mission to keep all staff, volunteers and families safe.
