#### 2022-2023 Program

The TLB program will run from September through April.

The board meets on the 1<sup>st</sup> Wednesday of the month with the exception of holidays or House conflicts.

Members are expected to attend all meetings and can have no more than 3 absences.

September 18<sup>th</sup> (orientation) is mandatory in person!

\*Due to Covid-19 the 2022-23 TLB school year may utilize virtual meetings and will require temperature checks upon arrival to in-person meetings/events, the use of face masks, and for students to practice social distancing within Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Carolinas. Students who are not comfortable with or unable to attend any in-person meeting can virtually attend.



# Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Carolinas Teen Leadership Board (TLB) Charter

#### **Purpose**

By serving as ambassadors for families of the Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Carolinas, students will gain leadership skills and fundraising experience so that they may take those skills and become life-long volunteers within the Upstate of South Carolina.

#### Composition

The TLB shall be comprised of high school students from participating area high schools, including home schools. The TLB shall have a minimum of 10 members and a maximum of 28 members annually. Students will be chosen based on prior leadership and service experience by a committee of RMHC volunteers and staff. Application materials and interviews will be used to select TLB members. Returning members are not guaranteed membership on future boards.

#### **Meeting Structure**

The TLB will meet the first Wednesday of each month at 6:00pm-7:00pm from October through April, with the exception of holidays or House conflicts. In addition, each member commits to lead service activities and attend TLB signature events outside of regular meeting times. Missing more than 3 meetings for any reason or being absent from the orientation in September or the assigned holiday service project in December may result in expulsion from the board.

#### **Overview of Duties**

- Serve as school and community ambassadors for the Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Carolinas
- Prepare and lead service activities for fellow Teen Leadership Board members and teens in the community
- Assist with the planning and execution of the TLB signature events
- Plan and Participate in the "Big Give Event"

#### Responsibilities

- Attend and actively participate in all meetings
- Come appropriately dressed and prepared for meetings with all required materials
- Attend TLB signature events and chosen/assigned service activities
- Raise awareness, donations or funds through individual "Big Give Event" projects
- Embrace opportunities to engage school and community with the House or educate others on RMHC

- In high school during the TLB school year
- Maintain good standing at school
- No drug or alcohol use and no profanity or inappropriate behavior
- Attend all meetings and events with safe, reliable, and on-time transportation to and from meetings

#### 1. Commitment

- A large part of volunteering is commitment. During the school year, TLB members are expected to attend all board meetings and stay for the duration of the meeting.
- b. In addition to meetings, TLB members will participate in leadership service activities, signature events, and a Big Give Event. If you sign up to attend another member's service activity, we expect to see you there! No-shows will not be tolerated.
- c. TLB members are expected to make their service on the board a priority. Missing more than 3 meetings for any reason or being absent from the orientation in September or holiday service project in December may result in expulsion from the board.

#### 2. Etiquette

- a. Every member of the TLB has skills, talents and ideas to contribute. Every member is expected to participate in meetings and give their best effort.
- b. Every member of the TLB has value and should be treated with respect. There should be no personal attacks—challenge ideas, not people. Every member should contribute to a supportive environment and maintain a positive attitude during meetings, projects and events.
- c. Treat RMHC staff, guest families, volunteers and fellow TLB members with respect and courtesy.
- d. Exhibit appropriate behavior at all times—no foul language, texting or other distracting and inappropriate behaviors. Inappropriate behavior may result in expulsion from the board.

#### 3. Dress Code

- a. TLB members serve as ambassadors of the Ronald McDonald House and should dress in a neat, clean and appropriate manner.
- b. Please wear appropriate clothing to all TLB meetings, events and service activities—clothing should provide appropriate body coverage and bare no offensive images or language.

#### 4. TLB Responsibilities

- a. Actively participate in meetings, contribute ideas and provide feedback.
- b. Attend all TLB meetings and events—arrive on time and stay to help clean up if needed.
